NOTICE OF RACE

FORMAT: This Regatta will be a two day match racing event for One-Design fleets targeted to provide as many races as possible during the weekend. A lecture will be presented Saturday morning to enhance participants' understanding of match racing tactics, strategies and rules. We will have on-the-water umpires during the starting sequences, but not over the whole course.

ELIGIBILITY: Each entrant must be a member of a yacht club or association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, racing a boat which is registered in the fleet in which it competes.

ENTRIES: A completed entry form, with an entry fee of \$50 for US Sailing members, or \$55 for non-members, payable to SBYRC, must be received by 1900 hours on **Tuesday, September 7, 2010**, or by arrangement with the event chair. Submit entries either on www.SBYRC.org or by mail to SBYRC, Box 10967, Marina del Rey, CA 90295.

RULES: This event will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, and any notices issued by the Race Committee which shall govern in case of conflict. Appendix C, Match Racing Rules, will apply except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

CLASSES: Pairing will be established based on entries received by 1900 hours on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, with a minimum of two boats and a total entry of twelve boats.

RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT with South Bay Yacht Racing Club (SBYRC)

In consideration of your acceptance of my entry, I agree as follows:

1. My yacht will be equipped to conform with any USCG or US Sailing safety requirements and those of the fleet in which I compete.
2. I agree to comply with the rules of the ISAF, as adopted by US Sailing and by all other rules and sailing instructions governing the event.
3. I certify that the boat entered has a valid PHRF certificate for this season or is registered in an established one-design fleet.
4. Any contestant or any member of the race or protest committee may inspect my yacht before or after the race.
5. I hereby release SBYRC, its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and committees from any and all liability for any injury to myself or my yacht arising out of their conduct of the race or my use of the facilities, provided that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my yacht. This waiver shall not be deemed as any indemnity on my part.
6. I assume any risk of injury arising out of my participation in the race, failure or breakage of my yacht or any of my equipment, or weather conditions.
7. I acknowledge that the safety and seaworthiness of my yacht is my sole responsibility and SBYRC, in accepting my entry, assumes no responsibility therefor.
8. I certify that I and my crew are able to swim.
9. I will notify the Club or the Race Committee immediately upon withdrawal from the race.
10. I own or have chartered the yacht entered and I am a member of a yacht club or sailing association that is a member of SCYA or US Sailing.

SCHEDULE: A **mandatory** skippers meeting will be held at 0900 hours on Saturday, September 11th 2010 at South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292, followed by a match racing lecture which is open to all crew. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1230 on Saturday and 1200 on Sunday. There will be run as many races as possible over the weekend. Six (6) flight are planned, fewer may be run at Racing Committee discretion; a debrief is schedule at 1730 after Saturday races at SCCYC. Each contestant will be given a packet at the skippers meeting with number assignment, flags and pairings.

RACING AREA: The racing area will be off the Venice pier northwest of the Marina del Rey breakwater, using inflatable and flag marks set by the Race Committee and described in the Sailing Instructions.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be handed at the skippers meeting.

NOTICES: Notices to Competitors will be posted on SCCYC notice board by 1030 on Saturday, September 11th , 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey.

TROPHIES & HOSPITALITY: All participants are invited to enjoy SBYRC's hospitality after each day of racing at South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292. Trophy presentation will be after the races on Sunday.
