NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 and the prescriptions of US Sailing (the “rules”; available for download at www.ussailing.org/rules/).
- 1.2. This event is considered **PHRF Category 4**.
For boats without life lines, a life jacket must be worn by both crews at all times.
- 1.3. Automatic steering systems and electrical autopilots may be used. This modifies RRS52.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta will have 2 starts:
Spinnaker (PHRF and Cruisers)
Non-Spinnaker (PHRF and Cruisers)
- 2.2. Classes will be established for Performance (PHRF) and Cruising fleets with a minimum of four entries, based on entries received by 1900 hours on Thursday July 22nd 2010.
- 2.3. A crew shall consist of two people; one of the “co-skippers” must be a member of a yacht club recognized by US Sailing and/or SCYA.
- 2.4. PHRF boats must hold a valid PHRF certificate.
- 2.5. Cruiser boats shall submit the cruising class form located at the end of the NOR. If a boat does not know its rating, SBYRC reserves the right to assign a rating that seems appropriate.
- 2.6. Eligible boats may enter either online or mail the attached form, which is also available at www.sbyrc.org and at the SBYRC drop box, located to the left of California Sailing Academy (CSA) main entrance, 14025 Panay Way, Marina del Rey (2nd floor, east end).
- 2.7. The entry fee is \$20 for U.S. Sailing members, \$25 for non-members. Entry can be made online (PayPal and Credit Card), or completed entry forms with entry fees will be accepted at the SBYRC drop box until 1900 hours **THURSDAY July 22nd 2010** or by mail to SBYRC, P.O. Box 10967, Marina Del Rey, CA 90295. Entries received thereafter will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. Sailing Instructions will be posted on our website at www.sbyrc.org and at the SBYRC drop box by 1900 hours, Friday July 23rd 2010.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACE

- 4.1. The RC will run one race for the Spinnaker class and one race for the Non-Spinnaker class.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155 hours.

5. THE COURSES

- 5.1. Courses will be selected from four courses using MDR Chart 16 marks; the courses will be attached to the Sailing Instructions.

6. THE START

- 6.1. The starting line will be in the vicinity of SS mark between a staff displaying an orange flag on or near the Race Committee boat at the starboard end and an inflatable tetrahedron at the port end.

7. FINISH LOCATION:

- 7.1. The finish line will be in the vicinity of the south entrance of the Marina Del Rey detached breakwater, between the green light and the committee boat anchored in Ballona Creek.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Scoring will be based on the SoCal PHRF Area B Random Leg Rating of each boat.
- 8.2. The Cruising Class will use handicaps based on the adjustments indicated on the ASMBYC Cruiser Class Handicapping Form.

9. TROPHIES

- 9.1. Individual take home trophies for each co-skipper will be awarded at PMYC, 13915 Panay Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292 after the race for each class based on the number of starters as follows:

1-4 starters = 1 trophy	8-11 starters = 3 trophies	6+ starters = 5 trophies
5-7 starters = 2 trophies	12-15 starters = 4 trophies	

10. HOSPITALITY

- 10.1. Saturday, at the skipper meeting, breakfast will be available for racers at PMYC at 0900 hrs.
- 10.2. Saturday post race hospitality will be held at PMYC

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See **RRS 4**. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

The organizing authority strongly suggests wearing a life jacket at all time during the race.

By listing a Handicap rating, I certify that I hold a valid certificate for that rating for this season; or by entering a one-design class, I certify that I qualify under the class rules. Any contestant or any member of the race or protest committee may inspect my boat before or after the race. I hereby release SBYRC, together with their officers, agents, employees and committees from any and all liability for any injury to myself, my crew or my boat arising out of their conduct of the race or use of the facilities, provided that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my boat. This waiver shall not be deemed as any indemnity on my part. I assume any risk of injury arising out of my participation in the race, failure or breakage of my boat or any of my equipment, or weather conditions. I acknowledge that the safety and seaworthiness of my boat, and the decision to race or keep racing, is my sole responsibility and SBYRC in accepting my entry, assumes no responsibility therefore. I will notify the Race Committee promptly upon withdrawal from the race. I certify that my crew and I are able to swim. I own or have chartered the boat entered, and I am a member of a Yacht Club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing.
